### Yes but....

- I don't have time....
- That's not my job.....
- I'm not here to molly coddle them...
- We've always done it this way;
- They're here to be punished not rewarded;
- I'm not a tree hugger;
- Nobody trained me to do that;
- There will be another fad along in a minute
- You'd only start fights among them.

# Why bother?

- We are more likely to effect change if we work
  WITH people rather than do things TO them;
- Our approach needs to enable people to take responsibility, rather than blame others;
- When we are invested in something, we really make it work: people step up;
- It reduces tension and creates a better environment for everyone;
- The skills are transferable I can use them anywhere.

What does it take to seriously engage with prisoners and empower them?

- Adaptive Leadership
- Letting go of control
- Being prepared to take a risk
- Joint training staff and prisoners
- Reviewing decision making processes
- Creating spaces to speak and be heard
- Be creative think outside the box
- Openness to change and doing things differently
